## Competent Person Training: Duration: 7-8 Hours

- Course covers the CAL- OSHA Title 8, Section 1540 through 1541.1 and Fed OSHA 1926 subpart P requirements pertaining to excavations, trenching and sloping techniques, protective systems and soils classification with an introduction to confined space entry safety.
- Our comprehensive training is essential to keep your company compliant with current OSHA regulations.
- Formative and Summative testing are both utilized to ensure retention.

## Confined Space Entry Training: 4-5 Hours

- Includes the new upgraded California and Federal standards for Confined Spaces in Construction: Cal OSHA Title 8, Chapter 4, Article 37, 1950-1962, and Fed OSHA 29 cfr 1926 AA 1201-1213
- Provides managers, foremen, competent persons, and workers with basic information regarding entry into confined spaces.
- Purposes: 1) create awareness of hazards associated with confined space entry; 2) help workers understand procedures to be followed when entering confined spaces.

- Training will update participant on the current requirements of the Competent Person
